BPW INTERNATIONAL HELP TO CHERNIHIV, UKRAINE

BPW Europe members are received in Chernihiv by the French Ambassador in Sofia, Bulgaria

First Counsellor Stéphanie Petitbon received a delegation from the BPW (Business and Profesional Women) NGO in Chernihiv, Ukraine at the Residence of France to present a donation made by the BPW International network for the benefit of local populations affected by the war.

The donation was initiated by Amélie Leclercq, a French entrepreneur living in Bulgaria and an active member of BPW International, and BPW UK President Joanne Kinsey, in partnership with the Bulgarian NGO Gorata and through international fundraising. The donation is for a new van to be given to the BPW Chernihiv branch to enable it to provide aid in better conditions. The van will leave Sofia for Chernihiv filled with basic necessities (medical aid kits, baby food, solar panels, solar chargers for mobile phones, etc.).
